CDA Raises Record High \$200,000 at Down Home Derby Fundraiser

Roswell, GA (May 17, 2023) – The Children's Development Academy (CDA), a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing high-quality early education to children from low-income families, raised a record-high \$200,000 in net proceeds at their 13th annual Down Home Derby fundraiser on May 6. Over 170 guests attended this year's fundraiser held at the Reid Barn in Cumming. The evening included a live viewing of the Kentucky Derby, dinner, dancing, and games to benefit the CDA.

"The highlight of the Down Home Derby this year was our Fund a Future," said CDA CEO and Executive Director Maggie DeCan. "It was so rewarding to be able to share the mission of the CDA with our guests and tell them exactly what their donations can help fund. I was absolutely overwhelmed with the generosity of our community to support our kids!"

The Fund a Future alone raised over \$50,000, which was matched by an anonymous donor at the event.

Currently the CDA serves more than 200 children ages 1 to 5 each year.
